Mediation clause

The parties shall endeavour to solve all disputes through negotiations.

Before either party shall bring any proceedings against the other party, the proceeding party shall notify the other of the cause of dispute, and that dispute shall be referred to a senior executive of each party, which senior executive shall try to resolve the dispute.

If the dispute cannot be solved through negotiations between the parties, such dispute shall be referred to mediation.

If the parties have not agreed on a mediator within 14 days after one of the parties has requested mediation, the mediator shall upon request of any of the parties be appointed by mediationcenter.

If the dispute has not been solved by mediation within 60 days from one of the parties' request on mediation, each of the parties may require that the dispute is finally settled by arbitration.
